EPA Definition of a Brownfield: A Brownfield is a property, the expansion, redevelopment, or reuse of which may be complicated by the presence or potential presence of hazardous substance, pollution, or contamination.

Identifying a Brownfield Site

- I. Site is sighted: The site is brought to the attention to the GASH Brownfield Tribal Response Program. Site is noticed by local tribes, community member, or other local person.
- II. Notify GASH Brownfield Program:

- IV. Log Inventory for Brownfield: Fill out *GASH Consortium Brownfield Inventory Form*.
- V. Apply Inventory to GASH Brownfield Public Record: Fill out *Public Record Form*.
- VI. Process for Prioritizing Brownfield Sites for the GASH Consortium
